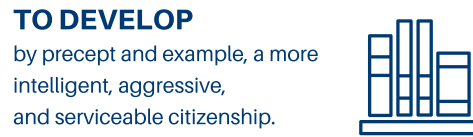

the daily living of the Golden Rule in all human relationships.



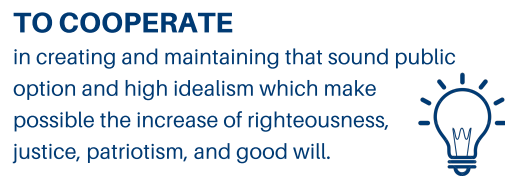

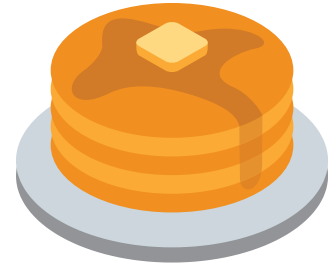
