All funds, 100%, raised in this and our other fundraisers are used to support our major programs throughout the year.

FLAG CONTRACT

The Kiwanis Club of the Greater Randolph Area is offering a service to all businesses in the Universal City, Schertz, Live Oak area. Pursuant to our citizenship goals, we display the American flag in front of participating business for ten observances during the year.

Jan - Martin Luter King, Jr. Day Feb - President's Day May - Memorial Day May - Armed Forces Day Jun - Flag Day Jul - **Independence Day** Sep - **Labor Day** Oct - **Columbus Day** Nov - **Veterans Day** Dec - **Pearl Harbor Day**

Flags are put up after dawn and taken down before dusk when good weather permits. We provide the flag, the holder, and the labor. **The cost for the service is \$40 per year**. During the past years, over \$100,000 has been returned to the community through this program.
